Strategic Environmental & Ecological Services, Inc. (STRATEGIC), on behalf of the Fayette County, Ohio Engineer, is submitting one copy of a Wetland Delineation and Surface Water Study Report for the above-referenced project site to your office for review and verification. The approximately 1,500 contiguous acres Mega Manufacturing Operation Site is located in Jefferson Township, Fayette County, Ohio.

Pursuant to this investigation, one freshwater wetland feature was identified within the study area boundary. The wetland feature, which has an aerial extent of approximately **0.15-acres**, was designated WL-A, and has been depicted on **Figure 2**. Additionally, two man-made open water ponds, presumed to be remnant borrow pits created during the construction of I-71, and the Missouri Ditch, a channelized tributary to Sugar Creek, were identified within the study area boundary.
