It was a pleasure meeting with you and the other Fayette County officials and discussing your potential super site. It is indeed a great location that will offer tremendous business and energy opportunities. As we presented at our June 30 meeting, your location is an excellent site for future natural gas firm transportation services. Due to this particular location, natural gas received down stream from the site, will accommodate future deliveries from most Dominion Transmission delivery points.

Your property is located near Dominion Transmission's TL 400 interstate pipeline that has over 600,000 Dekatherm per day of natural gas capability. This pipeline, per your maps, runs through both proposed super sites and with a common tap and meter & regulation station will easily accommodate both sites via a single service connection. In addition, it is only five miles away from an exiting compressor plant that will add to reliability.
